EXAMINATION AND PROMOTIONS

- 1. Pupils absent from the Examination for any reason are NOT reexamined, and lose their marks. In case projects are not submitted on the date assigned by the teacher, no marks will be awarded for the same.
- 2. Examination cannot be deferred nor can they be anticipated to suit the individual's convenience.
- 3. For Promotion a student has to obtain a clear pass of 33% in every subject.
- 4. A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue his/her studies in this school.
- 5. Any student found cheating or attempting to cheat in an examination will be given a zero in the paper and will not be allowed to appear for any other paper. Any kind of talking, making signs, exchanging seats or any chits will be understood as attempting to cheat.
- 6. A student who fails to be promoted shall thereby forfeit, for the ensuing year any concession in the fees and may be advised to leave the school, particularly if his/her conduct has not been satisfactory.
- 7. Good conduct, regularity and punctuality in attendance and a sense of responsibility are essential requisites for promotion.
- 8. Before appearing for a Public Examination candidates are required to pass the preliminary examination held in the school.
- 9. For sufficient reason such as unsatisfactory progress in studies, serious misconduct, dishonesty or absence from a Test or Examination, non-payment of fees, a pupil's name may be withdrawn from the list of candidates, even after he/she has passed the preliminary examination.
- 10. The results of the examination are final and cannot be re-considered.
- 11. Whenever there is a Parent-Teacher Meeting, students will have to accompany their parents in Full Uniform.
- 12. On no condition will promotion on trial be granted.
