

ANNUAL REPORT (2020-21)

Life is challenging and it must go on come what may. If the whole world is red-carpeted by the Grace of the Almighty, there wouldn't be any ups and downs at all and the occurrences of the world will be smooth and idyllic. Man may plan and predict and anticipate as per his capability but the Lord Almighty has His own plans. One of His plans of the year 2020 - 2021 was the Global Pandemic – COVID-19, which till date the whole world is fighting to put an end to.

Amidst the abundant blessings of the Almighty and the Global Pandemic commenced the New Session, but this year it was not the face to face session, rather it was online on various social media platforms like Whatsapp, Zoom, Google Classroom and others. Though, initially it wasn't easy for both the teachers and the students yet it offered a great learning experience to all of us. In other words it not only enhanced our social media skills but made us experts in dealing with it.

Commencement of the New session 2020 - 2021

In order to bring the students together, class groups from LKG to XII were created on Whatsapp in the month of April which have been in existence till date. A detailed annual syllabi for all the classes was designed with the teaching objectives, expected learning outcomes and Art Integration which was then executed in a well coordinated manner by the teaching faculty.

On the basis of the planned syllabus, assignments were sent in all the class groups in the form of typed PDFs, recorded videos and others. Along with these online assignments, online live classes were also conducted via Zoom Class. The Unit Tests and Midterm Exam were conducted online through Google forms which helped in the continuous assessment of the students' learning. All the students participated enthusiastically in all the online events as it was a new experience for them. The coordinators and the Principal met Online time to time to discuss the various plans in relation to the smooth conduct of the online exams.

The flame of the learning spirit and creativity should continue to burn always. Keeping this in view various trainings and competitions for the teachers and students were conducted online throughout the session.

Online Training Programmes for Teachers

Our teachers were introduced to the various learning and training apps like SWAYAM, DIKSHA, 30 – 30 STEM Program by IIT Gandhi Nagar, MY CENTA learning etc. They took active part in various subject training sessions



conducted virtually through these apps and by the CBSE and the NCERT. The teachers also attended the various live sessions and webinars conducted by the CBSE on the implementation of the NEP 2020. The trainings on DIKSHA app served as eye opener in this era of modern education and all the teachers acquired several skills through this program.

Co-curricular Activities

Young minds always remain hungry and yearn for doing divergent things. As a result the primary classes were provided with umpteen opportunities to showcase their talents and skills throughout the session. Various activities like Origami (paper folding), Bookmark Making, Diyas/candle decoration, lanterns, and decorative frills, Greeting card making, Diya Decoration, Rangoli designing were conducted

and the toddlers came out with wonderful, colourful and creative designs and ideas. They were also encouraged to monitor and maintain a healthy diet through Diet Chart completion. Furthermore a virtual cultural activity with patriotic fervor was organized for the little Angelites of classes I and II on the occasion of Republic Day.

The stage of pre-adolescence is always inquisitive and the best examples are our students. With a view to make the



students exploit their talents and curiosity, our school conducted several activities. These activities include English and Hindi Essay writing, Hindi Slogan writing, Letter writing, Science Olympiad, Rangoli Designing, and Poster Making. A virtual Patriotic Dance Competition was also conducted on the occasion of Republic Day.





The students of classes IX – XII were given many opportunities to demonstrate their talents. Activities like English and Hindi Essay writing, Slogan writing, Science Olympiad, Poster making, Rangoli Designing were conducted on different occasions.

A one week Mission Shakti Campaign was organized by the Government of Uttarpradesh in the month of October (on the occasion of Durga Puja) in which several activities like





making, essay writing (Hindi and English) were conducted for classes VI - XII. Our students took part enthusiastically and secured E-certificates.



Our school, being the Lead Collaborator of HOL (Hub of Learning – an initiative by the CBSE) conducted various online inter-school competitions like Poster and Rangoli making, for classes I – XII.



Many schools of Muzaffarnagar including ours participated in this event. All the winners of the member schools were appreciated by their respective Principals

Online Webinars and Counseling Sessions

To make the children aware of the COVID-19, our school in association with Montfort School, Roorkee conducted an online awareness Quiz-a-thon. All the participants were awarded with E-certificates by the host school.

A webinar was conducted by Procter and Gamble on Mother and Daughter Health and Hygiene. This counseling session was for the girl students of classes VI – VIII along with their mothers. This proved to be beneficial for all the young girls.

Another online counseling session was organized for the students of classes X and XII with a view to make them overcome the exam anxiety.

A webinar on the Personality Development for Global Leadership was conducted by the USM (Universal Solidarity Movement) in which all the students and teachers participated enthusiastically. Our teachers also took active part in The KNIT India



2020 which was organized by the USM. A group song, classical dance & skit were presented by our students in KNIT India 2020.



Our teachers, students and parents registered themselves for Pariksha Pe Charcha, an online interaction with the PM while some of the other teachers participated in the India Toy Fair 2021, which held virtually.

Celebrations


The festivities like Holy Angels' Day, Diwali, Christmas, were celebrated with the support staff and the hostel teachers.

197 students of class X and 151 students of class XII are going to appear for the Board Exams – May 2021. Keeping this in view Remedial classes for classes IX – XII were organized from the month of October, 2020. During these classes all the SOPs and protocols were followed strictly.
